ENROLMENT INFORMATION

Enrolments for Term 1 will be accepted from 9 January 2012. Please submit your form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment! Many of the children's classes book out quickly (ie. Cirque 1&2)

CLASSES

ACROBATICS JUNIOR

This class incorporates tumbling, hand balancing, trampoline, partner and group acrobatics. This is for participants of all ability levels. This class will increase flexibility and core strength as well as spatial awareness and confidence.

ACROBATICS SENIOR

This class incorporates training in tumbling, trampoline, vaulting, flexibility, handstands, hand balancing partner and group acrobatics. This class is for participants of all backgrounds and ability levels, so is great for beginners, but can also extend those looking for more specialized fields including trampoline and advanced tumbling. This class will increase flexibility and core strength as well as spatial awareness and confidence.

TINY TOTS

A parent/child participation class to get a taste of circus skills and have some fun together! This is a great springboard into other sports and of course into higher levels of circus training. This class is aimed at increasing gross and fine motor coordination and spatial awareness, while building confidence, strength and flexibility in growing kids!

Cirque 1&2

This class covers all the basics of circus, aerials, juggling, hula hoops, diabolo, tight wire, plate spinning, tumbling, stilt walking, unicycle and more. The numbers 1&2 refer to the year of school the participant currently attends. This class is a great way to let the kids experience circus and build up their confidence as they discover anew world of physical activity.

Cirque 3&4

This class incorporates all areas of circus, aerials, juggling, hula hoops, diablo, tight wire, plate spinning, tumbling, stilt walking, unicycle and more. It caters for beginners who have never tried their hand at circus before as well as those who have progressed through the cirque 1&2 program with us. The numbers 3&4 refer to the year of school the participant currently attends. This class is a great way to keep the kids engaged and doing something physical they can enjoy.

Cirque 5,6&7

Participants in this class are exposed to all areas of circus training including manipulation skills, tumbling, handstands, stilt walking, acrobalance and aerial skills. This class caters for the newcomer to the circus world as well as those who have been with us for years. This is a great way for kids to keep physically fit and learn some cool tricks along the way!

Cirque Teens

This class extends into that next level of general circus skills for those that have the experience but again caters for beginners too. This class gives that bit more insight into the many aspects of circus and gives the participants a chance to focus on their favourite part while still keeping up the skills in different areas. This is a great physical and social outlet for teens.

Classes Continued...

Manipulation Madness

This is a drop in skill sharing class for all hula hoopists, unicyclists, diabloists, jugglers and anyone else who would like to try out some circus manipulation skills. This is a social class with no set teacher. This is the perfect opportunity to meet others and socialize while having fun learning some new tricks!

Aerial Conditioning

For participants (18yrs and over) new to aerials who would like to build their upper and core strength. This class is compulsory if participants wish to advance into aerial classes for subsequent terms however it is not restricted to those participants. If you want to improve your physical fitness, and have fun doing it, this class is for you!

Teens Aerial Conditioning

This is a new class we are trialling for participants wanting to increase their fitness for aerials or to build up more general strength. This proves to be a fun and engaging way to increase strength and flexibility and in turn aerial ease. This class will be run subject to numbers, so get in on it!

Junior Aerials

This class covers all aspects of aerials including static trapeze, doubles trapeze, silks, Chinese pole, tight wire, lyra and rope. Children wanting to participate in this class must first complete at least one full term of cirque classes to learn safety and build up aerials strength.

Aerial Teens

This class is the next step up from junior aerials. Incorporating the same equipment, teens are extended in their skill levels, and begin to learn how to piece together performance pieces. Again, Cirque or Aerial Conditioning classes are a pre-requisite.

Aerial Adult Beginner

This class incorporates static trapeze, doubles trapeze, silks, Chinese pole, tight wire, Lyra and rope. Spaces for this class are limited due to the nature of the activity and as such there is a pre-requisite that students must first complete at least one term of aerial conditioning and must be assessed by trainer before moving into this class.

Aerial Adult Intermediate/Advanced Trapeze

Participants must have previous recent aerials experience have completed at least 1-2 terms of Aerial Adult Beginner and/or talk with aerial trainers to see if they are physically prepared enough to join this class.

Aerial Adult Intermediate/Advanced Silks

Participants must have previous recent aerials experience have completed at least 1-2 terms of Aerial Adult Beginner and/or talk with aerial trainers to see if they are physically prepared enough to join this class.

Work On Your Act

This is a youth training/performance group ages (14-25). Participation is by audition only. Contact the school if you would like to be considered with your current level of circus skill.

Acrobalance

The art of balance using only the human body. Bring a partner or come on your own, meet someone and stand on them! For beginner to working professionals. 16+ to Adults

LOCATION

The WA Circus School is located inside the Old Customs House building at 8 Philimore Street, Fremantle – a very short walk from the Fremantle Train Station.

There is an 'artsource' sign on the door of this building, and it's located across the road from the top of Mouat

Street and the corner of Cliff Street. The Fremantle CAT bus stop no. 27 is also right outside the front door.

Please ensure that you arrive early to secure a parking spot - the street can get busy around 5pm on weekdays. There is paid on street parking available on Philimore and the adjoining streets to the WACS.

There is also a drop off bay outside the WACS building.

AT THE CIRCUS CLASS

- Parents and additional siblings of younger students are welcome to stay and watch their child in class; however they must be quiet and keep siblings off the equipment. Alternatively you may drop participants off and head into Fremantle for the duration of the class.
- No food is to be consumed in the space, but please bring along a water bottle – there is a water tap for refills in the space.
- Participants are to wear comfortable clothes that they can move around in (i.e. shorts and t-shirt).
- No shoes are to be worn on the mats, but please bring along a pair of sandshoes to wear as needed for stilts or tightwire
- If you feel that your class may not be suitable age, experience or skill wise for you or your child, please talk to the trainers of the class about what might best suit.
